

AT&T IOT with the A920 on AT&T



You can install a AT&T SIM card to run transactions with a cellular connection.

IMPORTANT: Customers wishing to obtain a business IOT or "Internet of Things" account for mobile devices can do so and have those SIM cards work with PAX A920.

Pre-Requisites

- 1. Confirm that AT&T offers coverage in your area. Refer to the AT&T Map for coverage information: https://www.att.com/maps/wireless-coverage.html
- 2. Validate your terminal.

Use a terminal with the following part number: **A920-2AW-RD5-11EA NOTE**: Part numbers are located on a sticker on the back of your terminal.

Procuring a SIM Card

To acquire a SIM card, contact your AT&T representative and request the following:

2. Ask for **GPRS Mini-SIM** sized card (15mm x 25mm) **IMPORTANT:** Only GPRS SIM cards can be used.
